4. Honours Cumulative Grade Point Average: To continue in an Honours program, students must maintain a CGPA of at least 5.00. Students whose CGPA falls below 5.00 during the course of their studies may proceed in an Honours program, on warning, provided they meet the year level progression requirements. Students who are ineligible to continue in Honours may re-enter Honours if they raise their cumulative grade point average to 5.00 (C+) or above by the time they have successfully completed their 90th credit.
